FAQS

Q: Do these videos reflect the full diversity of Eden Invitation?

Not yet! Public witness about the intersection of faith and these experiences is not currently common. This can be further exacerbated when LGBTQ experiences intersect with another minority experience, such as race and culture. Over time, our Porch Series will expand to highlight the rich diversity of disciples across the LGBTQ spectrums, beyond same sex desires alone and featuring a variety of backgrounds, careers, and states in life.

Q: Can you tell me more about the language used in the videos?

You'll notice our community members move seamlessly between describing their experiences of sexuality and using adjectives to sum them up. We recognize that cultural terms in themselves carry their own origin story—be the words "homosexual" or "heterosexual," "gay" or "straight," anything around or in between! There is an array of thoughtful perspectives on which terms are better for believers. Eden Invitation requires that our members stand firmly in Catholic teaching on personal identity and sexual ethics. We do not, however, require uniformity in the adjectives used to describe one's experience of sexuality.

Q: How can I spark conversation with a group?

If you're hosting a watch party, the brief interludes between videos may not be enough time to really engage others. We recommend sticking around and asking each other a few simple questions:

- Which person did you relate to most and why?
- What would people find if they sat on your "porch"?
- How have these stories affected your understanding of people experiencing same sex desires in the Church? How will you grow from this experience?

Q: What do I do next?

Share these videos, keep in touch on social media, and schedule a cup of coffee with your LGBTQ friends to hear their stories too!
